Vegetarian Organic Waste

Composted on-site
(Do **NOT** use a plastic liner)

Kitchen Waste

Vegetable / fruit peels
Cooked food / leftovers
Egg shells
Rotten fruits / vegetables
Tissue paper soiled with food
Tea bags / coffee grinds
Leaf plates

Garden Waste

(small quantity only; from Apt)

Fallen leaves / twigs
Puja flowers / garlands
Weeds



Recyclable Dry Waste

Given to kabadiwala
(Use only **reusable** bags)

Wash, rinse, and dry!

Plastic

Plastic covers / bottles / boxes / items
Chips / toffee wrappers
Plastic cups
Milk / curd packets

Paper

Newspaper / magazines
Stationary / junk mail
Cardboard cartons
Pizza boxes
Tetrapaks
Paper cups and plates

Metal

Foil containers
Metal cans
Metal lids

Glass

Unbroken glass bottles



Reject Waste

Given to BBMP
(Wrap in paper)

Sanitary waste

(Use newspaper for wrapping)

Diapers / sanitary napkins
Bandages
Condoms
Nails
Hair
Used tissues
Medicines
Swept dust

Sharps

(Hand over separately)

Razors / blades
Used syringes
Injection vials
Broken glass

Construction debris / inerts
(Hand over separately)

Rubble / paints / bricks
Silt from drains
Cement powder
Flower pots



Non-Vegetarian Organic Waste

Given to BBMP
(Wrap in newspaper)

Cooked meat
Chicken/lamb/beef bones
Fish bones



Other Dry Waste

Given to BBMP
(Use only **reusable** bags)

Rubber / Thermocol
Old mops / dusters / sponges
Cosmetics
Ceramics, wooden chips
Coconut shells



Electronic Waste

Given to e-waste collection
(Use only **reusable** bags)

Keyboards / mice
Monitors
Batteries
Bulbs / tube lights / CFLs
CDs / tapes
Thermometers
